Annunciation Church Closing for Renovations

At the public meeting after Mass at Annunciation on Sunday, September 9th, parishioners were informed about the upcoming renovations. The idea for this project began with the need to address a safety and maintenance issue. The flooring under the pews was deteriorating and it was determined that it cannot be cleaned and maintained properly without doing more damage to it. Since the pews have to be removed to put the new flooring in, the Committee decided to look at some other things that could be done to enhance the comfort and beauty of our church. The pews will be re-installed with more space between them and the old, heavy kneelers will be replaced with lighter, more comfortable ones. LED lights will be installed in all the light fixtures to increase efficiency and new lighting for the sanctuary will include spotlights to highlight certain areas. The church will be cleaned from ceiling to floor and parts of it will be painted. To clear some of the clutter in the sanctuary and to bring greater visibility to the Communion of Saints who are present with us at Mass, the statues of Mary, Joseph, St. Jude, and St. Therese will be mounted on the walls in the sanctuary. The statues of the Sacred Heart, St. Anthony, and St. Anne will be moved to the shrine by the sacristy door. While we acknowledge there may be other areas of concern or ideas for improvement, we fully realize that we need to be conscientious stewards and take things slowly and with careful consideration so that we can be sure that what we do enhances the beauty and quality of our church's architecture. Over many years, money that parishioners have given to the church has been wisely invested. Therefore, we have enough savings to complete this project without asking anything from the parishioners. This is a gift to all of you on the occasion of our 150th anniversary as a way to preserve the beauty of the church and provide for the mission of the Church in Iliion for many years to come. The renovations will begin on October 15th and are projected to be completed no later than December 15th. The Mass times will remain the same, but all Masses will take place at Our Lady Queen of Apostles in Frankfort. I would like to thank the members of the Committee who helped me develop this proposal: Fran Reina, Skip Ames, Gary Greig, Cyndi Cardarelli, Dave Williams, Carol Lennon, Gary Slopka, Lisa Alexander, Bev Tutty, Fran Retzloff, Steve Lachacz, and Deacon Mike Carbone.
