

#### **EWTN July 2019 Family Newsletter**

Dear Family,

In my last letter I considered the beatitude: Blessed are the poor in spirit. This month I want to reflect on:

"Blessed are the meek, for they shall possess the earth."

In our power-driven society, meekness is something mistaken for weakness. Some may even think that there's not much difference between being meek and being a doormat. How wrong they are!

To authentically live meekness takes a hefty dose of strength, humility, integrity, and grit!

Knowing that meekness can be so easily misunderstood, Mother Angelica reminded us of how **Our Lord paved the way to meekness by His example**:

- Forgiving those who injured Him before thy asked forgiveness,
- Calmly facing the trials of daily life knowing of the Father's Providential care,
- Offering compassion to both friend and enemy,
- Striving to win the hearts of people by patience and forbearance rather than force.
- Correcting the faults of others out of concern for them and in perfect self-control.

Finally, this summer let us take this list to heart as we go about our work, our family lives and our vacations.

Maintaining meekness and peace of heart in the midst of unexpected crosses and contradiction is not easy to do. But it is possible, and it is richly rewarded with giant strides in holiness.

As meekness takes root, our hearts become more receptive and less defensive. We become more like children, and less domineering in our relationships. We become free to "possess the land" – as a gift, and not with a spirit of entitlement, or with grasping hands.

Despite Mother Angelica's fiery personality, many times I saw her striving to imitate Our Lord's meekness to a heroic degree. She is cheering all of us on as we, too, enter more deeply into the meekness of Christ, and live it out in our day-to-day life.
