# Blessed are They Who Hunger and Thirst



Mother Angelica saw a providential plan in the ordering of the Beatitudes. As we grow in **poverty of spirit and meekness** (the first two Beatitudes), we become more aware of our need to **mourn our sins** (third Beatitude). Having mourned our sins, we begin to **hunger and thirst for holiness**:

## The Fourth Beatitude:

**“Blessed are they who hunger and thirst for what is right: they shall be satisfied.”**

Mother Angelica tells us that *“to hunger and thirst after holiness is to be a person of unbounded desires”*.

Many times good people ask me to pray for them, in order that they might accept the cross. Their deepest desire, however, is not just to accept. Rather, their deepest desire is to receive healing, to become a saint, and thus to embrace the cross in union with Jesus for the salvation of souls. To express such desires to the Lord, especially in the face of suffering, takes daring and fortitude. Our Lord plants such desires within us because He wants to bring them to fruition in extraordinary ways, *though not always in ways we expect!*

**God desires to satisfy us beyond our wildest dreams. We must dare to hunger for holiness!**

**Mother Angelica gives us the following practical tips on how we can hunger and thirst for what is right:**

Put God and His Kingdom in first place;

Do God's Will moment by moment;

Love neighbor unselfishly, not trying to make him over in our own image;

Spend time each day in prayer and planning how to overcome our faults;

Understand the power of good example;

Practice honesty in our relationship with God, with ourselves, and with our neighbors;

Make sure our desire for holiness, and our effort to attain it, grow proportionately;

Be careful that our goal to become holy with God's grace supersedes every other goal.

Matthew, or Levi, the Apostle and traditional author of the first Gospel, met Christ while he was collecting taxes in Capernaum. Half of a verse tells the story: "He said to him, 'Follow me.' And he got up and followed him." (Mt 9:9). This moment of encounter between our Lord and Matthew, the sinner, has captured the imagination of many artists, most notably Caravaggio. *Matthew can also be recognized in the Church's art by his symbols: the book of the Gospel, the winged man, and the sword-the supposed instrument of his martyrdom.*
