### Why Communion on the Tongue?

Some parishioners have asked why I am distributing Holy Communion on the tongue when “nobody else is doing it.” First, and most importantly, I cannot deny anyone Holy Communion on the tongue. I do not have the authority to do so because it is a right given to the faithful by the universal law of the Church. Second, it is simply not true that “nobody else is doing it.” Just because you have not seen a priest doing it proves nothing. You obviously have not been to every parish in Herkimer County, let alone the Diocese of Albany, because if you had, you would have seen plenty of other priests distributing Holy Communion on the tongue. Third, you are only required to receive Holy Communion once a year, at Easter. Therefore, if you are not comfortable receiving at this time, there is no obligation to do so and you need not come forward. Finally, I heard about this from a parishioner who was relaying it from others. In the future, if you have a question or concern, please speak directly to me instead of asking someone else to do it. Why? Because that is what Jesus commanded us to do: “If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone” (Mt 18:15). I do not want to hear your questions or concerns from someone else; I want to hear them from you, the one offended, because only the one who offends you can do anything about it. Doing it this way also prevents the issue from spreading to other members of the community who have no right or need to know.

### Tuan's Vocation Talk

For those of you who were away the weekend of July 18 -19, seminarian Tuan Cao spoke before Mass about how he was called to discern a vocation to the priesthood.

I am very happy and grateful to be here and to share my vocation story. Every person has a different calling. Some are drawn to become a doctor, a teacher, or perhaps a policeman. My calling is to become a priest. Have any of YOU thought about the priesthood? Why do I choose this discernment?

First of all, my vocation was established early when I was a child. I was born and grew up in a small village in the middle of Vietnam. It is a peaceful and quiet village; people live together farming and fishing. Life is simple, happy, humble and peaceful. Every morning, we are awakened by the church bells, which call us to church. It is a sign of a new day beginning. There are many people who come to pray and to worship God, the young and the old alike. I would accompany my grandmother to church. She taught me a lot of things such as making the sign of the Cross, reciting the Our Father and the Hail Mary. These were simple acts; however they affected me deeply. In my village, Mass begins early at 4:30 AM because people need to go to the fields. Later in the afternoon, when the sun goes down, church bells ring signaling the end of the workday. This is ABSOLUTELY the perfect time to come back to church in order to pray and to worship God. This makes me happy, and it encourages me to find Jesus in my life. It is my dream to become a priest.

The second thing I would like to share with everyone is the story of my family. I was born in a strong Catholic family, a traditional family, with eight people including four older brothers, one younger sister and me. Family helped me in discerning to become a priest. And, of course, they always pray for me, and support me, in my journey to the priesthood. I'd like to share a childhood memory. I really loved when Father celebrated the Mass and gave the homily. Also, when he spoke - he looked very humble and holy. From that time on, I loved the priesthood! I also really loved being an altar server, an organist, a pianist and a member of the choir. I participated in Bible classes, in doing volunteer work with Catholic Charities, visiting people, etc. Of course, I pray and I study to “get it”.

As you can see, the priesthood is so important, as it comes from God. God loves everyone; however, He chooses some men to follow Him into the priesthood and He is choosing me. God has called me to study and to become a priest in the United States. I pray that everyone here will continue to pray for me and to support me as I continue my endeavor towards the priesthood. While there may be challenges, I am confident that by the grace of God and by your prayers, I will be able to continue to know, to love and to serve God, the Church and the people and that my journey toward the priesthood will come to fruition. Thank you everyone for listening, and may God continue to bless each of you abundantly.



## CHANGES TO THE BISHOP'S APPEAL
