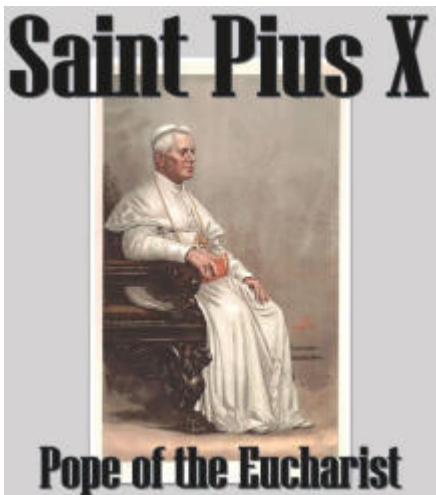

Proper Reception of Holy Communion

Since Sunday Masses resumed on June 14th, I have made an announcement before distributing Holy Communion. I have done this for several reasons. **First**, and most importantly, many have not been properly taught, or they have forgotten, how to properly receive Holy Communion. This is of the utmost importance because what we do affects what we believe. Faith in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist is waning. We need to do all we can, therefore, to bolster people's faith in this amazing gift of Jesus' True, Flesh-and-Blood Presence among us. **Second**, I needed to explain how to line up along the altar rail and let you know you have the option of receiving either standing or kneeling. If you are sitting together in the pew, you may kneel/stand together at the altar rail. When you arrive at the first pew, if you are first in line, go to the far end of the altar rail where the kneeler pad begins. Do not stop half-way down. **If you receive Holy Communion in the hand:** 1) Remove your mask before I present the Body of Christ to you. 2) Place your hands one on top of the other, not side by side, and keep them flat. 3) Do not move your hands or your thumbs until I have moved away so as to avoid contact with my fingers. 4) Consume the host immediately; do not walk away with Jesus in your hand.

If you receive Holy Communion on the tongue, do not move your head; keep it still and wait for Jesus to come to you. It is much easier while kneeling, so if you are able, please kneel. When I approach you, close your eyes and rotate your head upwards as if you are raising your eyes to heaven. If you keep your eyes open, the tendency is to react as the host is moving toward you, which makes it harder for me to give you Holy Communion. After receiving Holy Communion, it is the ancient tradition of the Church to return to your pew and make an act of thanksgiving, i.e. a prayer of gratitude to God for blessing you with the Holy Bread of Eternal Life. **Third**, I wanted to remind everyone to remain in church until I process out of the sanctuary at the end of Mass.



Saint Pius X

Pius X was born Giuseppe Sarto in Riese, Italy, of poor, hardworking parents. Before his election as pontiff in 1903, he labored unceasingly as parish chaplain, bishop, and then Patriarch of Venice to awaken the hearts of the people. During his pontificate he condemned the Modernist heresy and promoted the catechesis of adults and children, priestly formation, and frequent reception of the Eucharist. He allowed First Communion to be given to children as young as seven. Many miraculous cures were attributed to this "pope of the Eucharist" during his lifetime. He died in 1914. *-Magnificat*

Bowing Head at Name of Jesus

Question: I don't understand why, over the last couple of years, I don't see folks bowing at the name of Jesus. It doesn't seem to matter whether they are parishioners, priests or nuns. Is there some new rule on this, or am I just too old school Catholic? (Lacey, Washington)

Answer: The custom of bowing at the name of Jesus is a worthy one, and has a long tradition in the Church. It takes its origin from St. Paul, who wrote in his Letter to the Philippians (2: 9-10): "God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every other name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend . . . and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord."

The practice was reinforced at the Second Council of Lyons, convened in 1274 by Pope Gregory X, which highlighted the special honor due the sacred name & noted that "whenever that glorious name is recalled, especially during the sacred mysteries of the Mass, everyone should bow the knees of his heart, which he can do even by a bow of his head."

I agree with our letter-writer that, over the past several decades, this practice is followed less widely. I also agree that more people should observe it; it serves as an important reminder of the reverence we owe the divine and reflects an interior desire to honor Jesus, who died on the cross to redeem us.

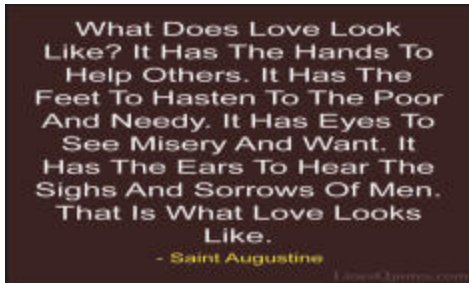
CHANGES TO THE BISHOP'S APPEAL

We want to let you know about a few changes to the annual campaign formerly known as the Bishop's Appeal:

The campaign will now be known as the *Diocesan Appeal* and themed, "For we walk by faith, not by sight." (2 Corinthians 5:7)

- There will no longer be "in-pew" collection of pledges.
- The 2020-2021 Diocesan Appeal will begin with a mailing sent to parishioners from the Roman Catholic Diocese of Albany (RCDA) - Office of Stewardship and Development. You should expect to receive this correspondence between now and early September; it will include a pledge card and envelope.
