Proper Reception of Holy Communion

Since Sunday Masses resumed on June 14th, I have made an announcement before distributing Holy Communion. I have done this for several reasons. **First**, and most importantly, many have not been properly taught, or they have forgotten, how to properly receive Holy Communion. This is of the utmost importance because what we do affects what we believe. Faith in the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist is waning. We need to do all we can, therefore, to bolster people's faith in this amazing gift of Jesus' True, Flesh-and-Blood Presence among us. **Second**, I needed to explain how to line up along the altar rail and let you know you have the option of receiving either standing or kneeling. If you are sitting together in the pew, you may kneel/stand together at the altar rail. When you arrive at the first pew, if you are first in line, go to the far end of the altar rail where the kneeler pad begins. Do not stop half-way down. **If you receive Holy Communion in the hand:** 1) Remove your mask before I present the Body of Christ to you. 2) Place your hands one on top of the other, not side by side, and keep them flat. 3) Do not move your hands or your thumbs until I have moved away so as to avoid contact with my fingers. 4) Consume the host immediately; do not walk away with Jesus in your hand.

If you receive Holy Communion on the tongue, do not move your head; keep it still and wait for Jesus to come to you. It is much easier while kneeling, so if you are able, please kneel. When I approach you, close your eyes and rotate your head upwards as if you are raising your eyes to heaven. If you keep your eyes open, the tendency is to react as the host is moving toward you, which makes it harder for me to give you Holy Communion. After receiving Holy Communion, it is the ancient tradition of the Church to return to your pew and make an act of thanksgiving, i.e. a prayer of gratitude to God for blessing you with the Holy Bread of Eternal Life. **Third**, I wanted to remind everyone to remain in church until I process out of the sanctuary at the end of Mass.

CHANGES TO THE BISHOP'S APPEAL

Optional Memorial - September 12th

Saint Louis de Montfort wrote that "the salvation of each individual is bound up with the Hail Mary." Why? Because it was when the Archangel greeted Mary that our Savior became flesh in her womb. To be Christian is to carry on that Annunciation unceasingly by repeating the Hail Mary. This prayer, which speaks the holy name of the Mother of God, "brought to a dry and barren world the Fruit of Life. It will cause the Word of God to take root in the soul and bring forth Jesus." The holy name of Mary bears such power because of the unique bond between Mother and Son. "When God went his Son born of a woman, he instituted a once-and-for-all order of salvation in which the union of Mother and Child stands at the center" (R. Cessario). To accept the divine privilege of speaking the name of Mary is to participate in that saving union.

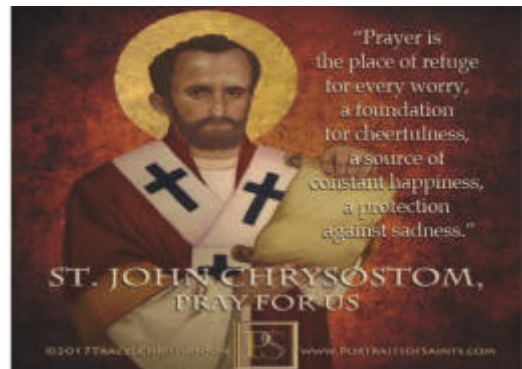
